

Notification definitions specify an event about which you can be notified by Docusnap via email. This could be an expiring contract that you have entered in the additional information, or if a certain software was found during inventory.

The current notification definition checks **if an underlicensing has been detected in Docusnap**. The results of the inventory carried out are checked for specific results.

We recommend running the corresponding report daily. If underlicensing is detected, an email will be sent with an attached Excel file.
